We are now in 14, Finkin Street, Grantham which is just down the street from the old centre and closer to the High Street.

The new premises have much cosier, inviting and user friendly facilities with a good size meeting / activity room complete with kitchen facilities. A coffee and tea bar has been put together so groups can be well catered for when they use the facilities. We have a lovely seating area with a couple of sofas complete with a daylight reading lamp for people to relax in. Also we have now got a lovely electronic organ in the centre so if you fancy a tinkle of the ivories you will be most welcome to come along and entertain yourself and us. It is our hope that as well as us hosting the usual coffee mornings, meetings, events and equipment days we will have the opportunity of hosting social activities too. There are separate gents and ladies toilets with disabled facilities too. We have a portable ramp so anyone wishing to have access in a wheelchair can get into the building without any problems. If you need this facility all you need do is to ring the assistance bell at the outside door entrance and someone will come and help.
